Beacon Preceptorships teach relationship-based, whole person healthcare that addresses the physical, mental, emotional, relational and spiritual well-being of patients, with the goal of developing spiritually resilient health care professionals who are equipped to bring the healing of Jesus into the exam room, the office, the hospital, the specialty center, and the academic teaching setting.

Program Description:

Fourth year/residency elective options that include patient care and 2 didactic sessions/week*

The Beacon 360° experience includes:

- In-office clinical sessions with our internists, pediatricians, ob/gyn's, and podiatrist
- Spiritual Care sessions with our spiritual care coordinators
- Nutrition Counseling – may include in-office, home visits and healthy cooking classes
- Community outreach opportunities with our Outreach team, as well as local churches
- Involvement in specific staff meetings if they occur during the rotation
- Feedback with a goal of creating at least one key “forming experience” during the rotation

Dedicated didactic mentoring sessions (*subject to change based on situation) will explore:

- How to apply the Word to your faith, your work and your calling
- “How do we bring Jesus into the exam room? The hospital? The classroom?”
- Addressing issues in the “public square”
- Personal spiritual accountability and resiliency-building
